#### **PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE**

It has been a very worthwhile 2 weeks in classrooms watching students being challenged to think deeply by their teachers. This is to prepare students for the achievement of higher order thinking which is an essential ingredient to making students more effective and efficient problem solvers.

The school's strategic plan is almost complete, we are just awaiting final feedback from the P&C this coming Tuesday. This is our 4 year plan and is then translated into a detailed plan every 12 months called an AIP.
