- Improve staff understanding of the Australian Curriculum (AC) and align goals and feedback to the AC to lift outcomes for all students to 95% A-C and 60% A-B, U2B 45% Yr 3 and 45% Yr 5 and NMS 95%
- Improve transitions to prep by engaging ECEC community in a productive partnership: 90% of transition statements received by 2022, 100% of prep staff using data to inform practice to lift K-2 outcomes
- Close the gap on Indigenous student attendance and academic performance to less than 2%
- Improved reasonable adjustments for students with a disability by all staff, co-teaching, curriculum meetings and quality assurance around the teaching of students on an Individual Curriculum Plan
- Further grow the capability of teaching staff through regular coaching each term.

- Improving English outcomes for students K-2 including Early start and transition program as
 evidence shows that students who don't pass English by year 2, struggle throughout their
 schooling.
- Support teacher to lift A-C result with teacher aide support driven by year levels. Supports staff and Deputy Principals.
- Speech Language Pathologist to help identify student deficits and strategies for improvement.
- Closing the gap for indigenous students, academically, culturally and in attendance.
- Lifting outcomes for students with disability.
